



## Payment and Pricing

*Transparency regarding our payment policy and pricing is of the utmost importance to us. Please review the following points and do not hesitate to call our office with any questions.*

1. First and foremost, our goal is to provide the most effective, yet efficient care possible.
  - We have no set script of what testing options will be pursued or how many appointments will be necessary. We work according to what the labs indicate and what you and your clinician aim to achieve.
2. We are a direct-pay practice, which means we do not bill your insurance company and payment is expected in full for the appointment at the time of service.
3. Each appointment is billed according to the amount of time spent with your clinician.
  - The amount of time necessary for an appointment cannot be predetermined to decrease the expense. We have a responsibility to engage in a comprehensive discussion, if necessary, and we will not compromise on that notion.

<b>New Patient Appointment</b>	30 minutes to 1 hour	\$300 - \$450
<b>Follow-up Appointment</b>	Typically 15 or 30 minutes	Typically \$150 or \$300 Price may be less or more depending on length of appointment.
<b>Pre-payment with Reduced Rate per Appointment</b>	30 minutes available per appointment – Minimum of 3 Appointments must be pre-paid for.	\$675 total for 3 Appointments
